

FOOTPATH REPORT FOR MONDAY 20th JULY

Footpaths

There have been a few reports of overgrown footpaths, on the Lovells Estate and near the stables off Mill St.

Upon investigating, there is a small area where the bushes are growing across the footpath on the Lovells Estate, this is near the entrance to West View Gardens. I believe this will be the responsibility of the Lovells estate maintenance team to cut back.

I have also checked the footpath nr the stables and any growth obstructing the footpath has been cut back, so no issue. Whilst in this area, I did notice that FP59 which is on the PC cutting list has not been cut. This has been reported to Richard Adams to cut.

FP51, which is next to the postbox on Mill St, I found this was badly overgrown with nettles and brambles, so I have cut it back. I believe this FP is on the SCC list, but has not been cut. I have reported this to the PROW Manager.

Although I did have to cut back some brambles on the Bowling Alley, someone has been along the FP and has cut back the brambles, previously.

Gislingham Circular Walks

It is intended to get these leaflets reprinted with updated information. ie. where new footpaths have been made and some closed. Also, I will be adding the FP numbers to make it easier for the walker to identify the route.
